PARKING

- ✦ **All participant parking** must be at the Permanence - E. L. Crossley Secondary School.
- ✦ **No parking will be allowed on the side of the race course and staging road.** Vehicle park on the side will be required to move or towed at their own expenses.
- ✦ A shuttle service will run between the Permanence parking and the Start / Finish / Feed Zone area.
- ✦ Club or team with minimum 4 registered participants may register for a space at the Club & Team Pit. Reserve via the online form. One request per club or team. First come; first served - [SBC Club & Team Pit Registration Here](#)

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Plan extra driving time due to the holiday weekend. Heavy traffic and longer delays are expected on the QEW Niagara bond.

- ✦ **Arrive via Hwy 20.** Expect short delays from race traffic and respect directions given by police or race volunteers and marshals.
- ✦ Do not drive on the race course against the race direction. A one way traffic flow will be enforced on the majority of the race course during the entire race day, on Saturday May 18 from 07:45 until 18:00.
- ✦ Effingham St. will be closed to all traffic.

From GTA / Hamilton via QEW

1. Take Queen Elizabeth Way (QEW) towards Niagara.
2. Take exit 57 for Victoria Avenue/County Road 24 toward Vineland.
3. At exit, bend right onto South Service Road / Marina Blvd.
4. At the light turn left / south onto Victoria Ave. (County Road 24 S).
5. In about 15Km, turn left / east onto RR 20 E (Highway 20).
6. In about 5 Km, the permanence and parking will be on the right at E.L. Crossley Secondary School.

From GTA/Hamilton Map

1. On HWY 406 take exit Fonthill HWY 20.
2. Head west on HWY 20.

ELIGIBILITY / PARTICIPATION

- ✦ To be able to register and participate, in any categories, all athletes must hold a valid UCI licence and be a resident of Ontario.
- ✦ OCA Citizen Permit, One-Day Event Permit, or any domestic license of Canada/USA or other countries are not accepted at the Provincial Championships.
- ✦ All participants must be licensed to compete in their appropriate category.
- ✦ All participants must be prepared to present their licence upon demand at the event.
- ✦ UCI licence will not be sold on race day. Contact the OCA regarding any licensing questions. Email [OCA](mailto:OCA@ocanet.ca) Phone 416-855-1717 OCA online application for a UCI Licence: [OCA Online Membership Registration](http://www.ocanet.ca/membership).
- ✦ All licensing questions must be submitted to the OCA 48 hours prior to the event, in order for us to troubleshoot licensing issues effectively.
- ✦ Athletes are not considered registered for an event until all administrative requirements have been fulfilled:
 - ✦ Must hold a valid license at time of registration,
 - ✦ Completed online registration,
 - ✦ Waiver(s) signed,
 - ✦ Payment transacted.

 - ✦ Men - U19, U23, Elite, and Master A (30-39), B (40-49), C (50-59), & D (60+);
 - ✦ Women - U19, U23, Elite, and Master A (30-39), B (40-49), & C (50+)
- ✦ The categories are defined as per Cycling Canada and Ontario Cycling rules based on the year of birth.
- ✦ Participants must enter their event class as shown on their licence.

If you are informed that the race has been stopped due to lightning, you are advised to seek shelter until the race can resume. There are no refunds if the race must be cancelled due to extreme weather conditions.

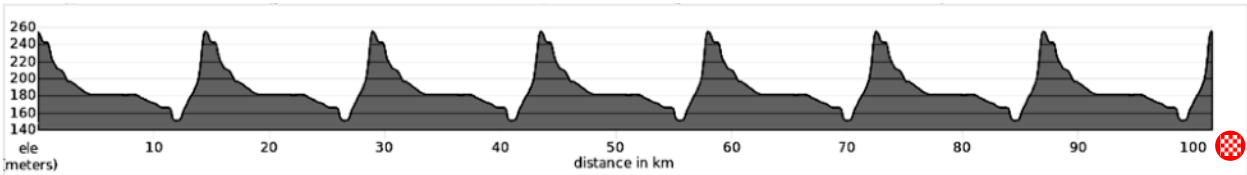

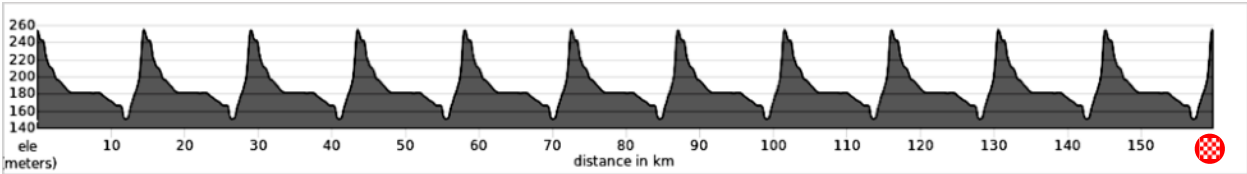
MM C & D | 5 Laps | 72.5 Km | 581 m



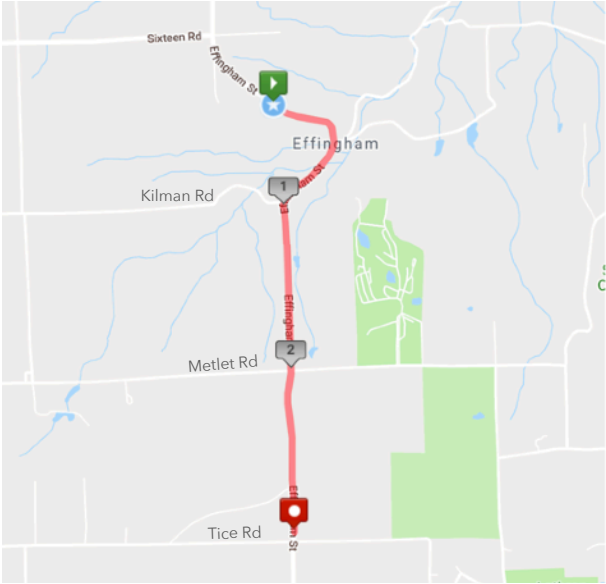
MU19, WE & MM A & B | 7 Laps | 101.5 Km | 813 m



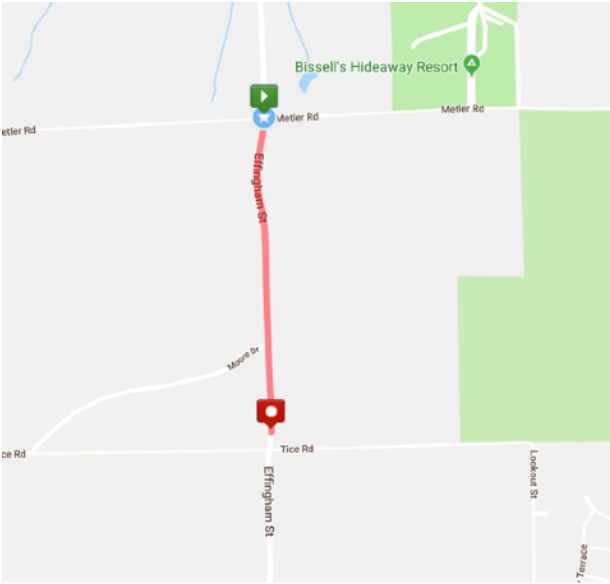

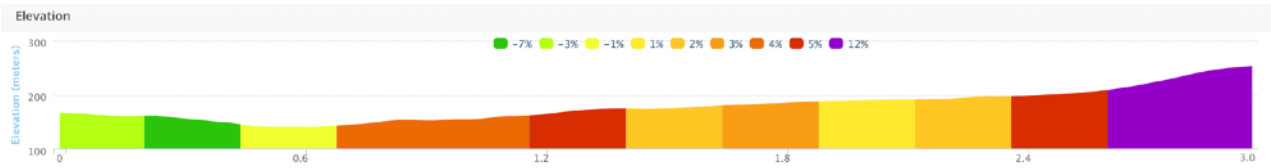
LAST 3 KILOMETERS



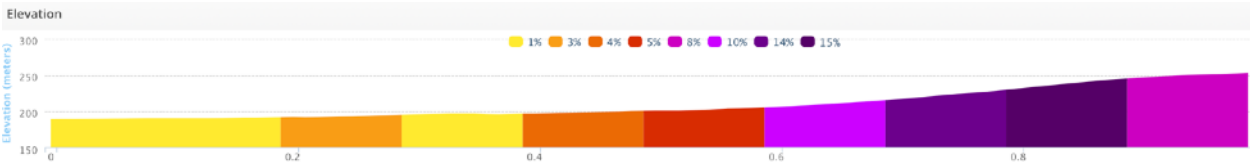

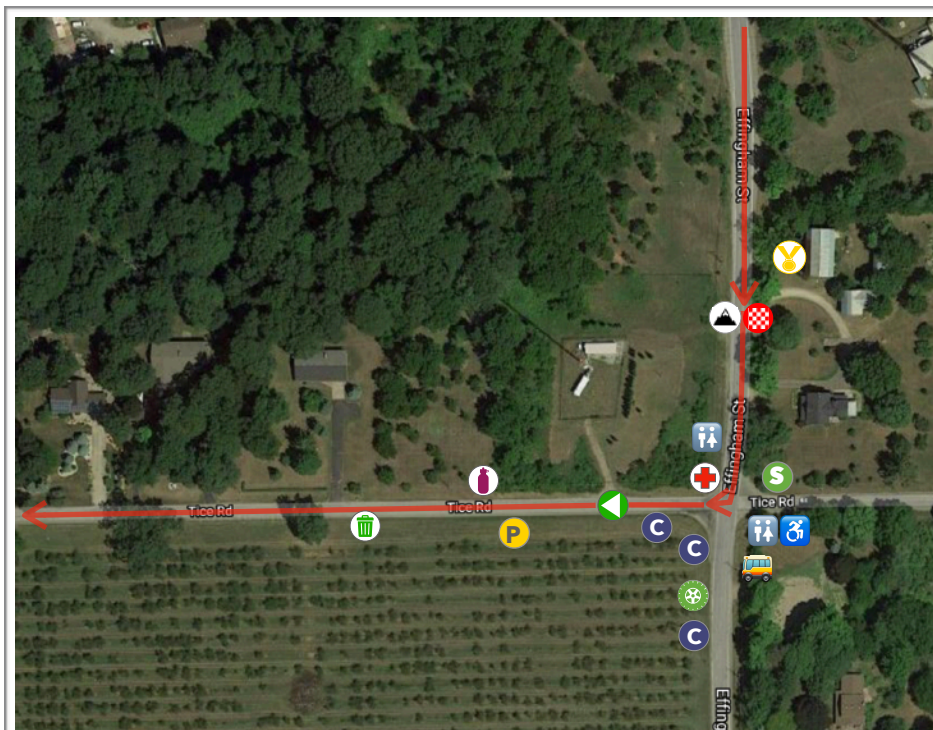

RULES & REGULATIONS

1.0 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS


- The 2019 Steve Bauer Classic shall be governed by Ontario Cycling Association (OCA).
- The event(s) will be run under UCI, CCC and OCA rules and regulations.
 - [UCI Regulations](#)
 - [CC Companion Guide 2018-F-1 \(March 2018\)](#)
 - [OCA Companion Guide April 2012](#)
 - [OCA Road Race Communiqués](#)
- UCI scale of penalties shall apply with CCC and OCA modifications.
- Equipment regulations will be enforced for all categories.
- Approved helmets are mandatory for training and competition.
- 7.93 Meters is the maximum rollout for U19 participants as per the UCI regulation.
- The participants, coaches and staff are all responsible to know and obey all rules and regulations from UCI, CC, OCA and race organiser

1.1 NUMBER PLACEMENT

- 2 numbers must be worn: one horizontal on the back right pocket and the second vertical on the right lower back without overlapping each other. (see images below).
- Trimming or folding of bib numbers will result in a fine.



1.2 FEED ZONE

- Feeding will be authorised on the laps outlined by this icon  in the Race Itinerary page 12.
- Feeding will not be permitted on the final lap in any race unless the Chief Commissaire explicitly makes this allowance.
- The Feed Zone is located on Tice Road west of Effingham St. on the north side of the road.
- Parking will not be permitted at the Feed Zone. See shuttle information from Race Permanence.
- Feeder must feed their racer from the right side of the road.
- Feeder please use extreme precaution crossing the street from the Club & Team Pit area.

1.3 RACE COURSE SPECIFICS

- The race course will be secured by police officers and marshals at intersections.
- A one way traffic management plan will be implemented to provide an optimal racing environment on narrow roads where yellow lines are not displayed.
- The Ontario Cycling rule 2.2025 bis (Yellow Line Rule) will be in effect and enforced on the portion of the course from Sixteen Road at Maple Street to Effingham Street at Kilman Road. See Race Course Map page 8.
- Commissaires reserve the right to disqualify riders for blatant or intentional breach of the "Yellow Line Rule".
- The race will have full use of Effingham St. from Kilman Road to Tice Road (finish).
- Residents living on the race course have been informed to depart and access their homes by driving in the direction of the race course.
- The above traffic management plan imposed cannot fully ensure that no vehicles may approach the race driving the opposite direction of the race course. Reminder, there is the possibility of traffic (vehicular, cyclist, pedestrian, animal) at all times; participants are cautioned to be alert for any potential dangers.
- Any rider visiting the course to train on and its surrounding roads are urged to obey all traffic rules and signs. Please, do not litter, when it comes to your gel packs, bar wraps, fruit peels, bottles, etc. Your full cooperation is required. Please respect the community who supports and allows us to keep running this event.
- No race day warm-up is permitted on the course. Participants can warm-up on Effingham Street south of Hwy 20.
- No free laps will be granted on any situation or incident.
- Team vehicles will not be permitted on the race course for any event, nor to follow the races while in progress.
- Designated neutral service vehicles will be supplied by the organisation and assigned to follow every race wave's heats.
- Participants are required to bring their own spare wheels to be placed in the neutral service vehicles before the start of their race at the designated Wheel Drop Off on Effingham St. at the south-west corner of Tice Rd. All wheels must be clearly marked with the participants' number and race category. Although efforts will be made to provide a participant's own spare wheels in the event of a

mishap, in the interests of servicing a participant quickly, neutral support may supply wheels at random.

- ✦ The organisation and neutral service will not be responsible for damage to wheels, even resulting from use by other participants.
- ✦ The neutral service vehicles will return to the Caravan Staging area on Tice Rd & Effingham St. after each race for participants to pick up their wheel. Race organiser or neutral service is not responsible for lost wheels.
- ✦ Participants in need of mechanical service from the neutral service vehicle or other mean must stop on the right hand side of the road to receive mechanical service.
- ✦ Littering on the course will not be tolerated, and sanctions will be applied on the first offence. A designated waste zone will be established. The participant must safely and exclusively deposit their waste on the sides of the road in the designated area.
- ✦ On the start of the last lap, any participants with more than 10 minute gap behind the lead group will be pulled off and a prorated finish time will be attributed.
- ✦ Time cut off percentage is listed for all categories on the Race Schedule. See page 7.
- ✦ Participants about to be lapped will be pulled from the course.
- ✦ As soon as possible, after the end of the race, unofficial results will be posted online through Race Timing website racetiming.ca for 15min.
- ✦ On confirmation of the final results, they will be posted online on Race Timing website racetiming.ca. One hour after official posting, there will be no more results modifications.

1.4 AWARDS

Steve Bauer Classic

- Each winner will be awarded a Giordana Steve Bauer Classic Yellow Jersey.
- Prize money will be awarded to the first 3 finishers of each category.
- Mountain Classification prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers of this classification.
- There are no O-CUP points for this Ontario Provincial Road Championships.

Road Provincial Championships

- Provincial championship medals and jerseys are only awarded to licensed riders, residing in Ontario
- To be awarded a medal there must be N+1 starters in the category, even if there are mixed categories on the course at the same time.

- To be awarded the provincial championship jersey there must be at least five (5) starters in the category.

To be awarded a Gold medal	There must be at least two (2) starters in the category
To be awarded a Silver medal	There must be at least three (3) starters in the category
To be awarded a Bronze medal	There must be at least four (4) starters in the category
To receive a champion jersey for 1 st place	There must be at least five (5) starters in the category

1.4.1 CLASSIFICATIONS

- **Mountain Classification** (KOM and QOM) will take place in ME1-2 and WE1-2 categories only.
- KOM points - 5pt, 3pt, 2pt & 1pt point(s) will be awarded to the first 4 ME1/2 participants crossing the finish line on lap # 3, 5, 7 & 9.
- QOM points - 5pt, 3pt, 2pt & 1pt point(s) will be awarded to first 4 WE1/2 participants crossing the finish line on lap #2, 4, & 6. Prizes to be paid out to the top 3 finishers who accumulate the most points.
 - Participant must complete and finish the race.
 - Tie breaker to be awarded to the participant who has the most first place points on the KOM/QOM line.
 - If still tied, the winner will go to the highest position on the final KOM/QOM disputed.

1.4.2 AWARD CEREMONIES

- All participants who have placed on the SBC & Provincial podium must attend the award ceremonies in their racing kit. Failure to do so will result in a fine and loss of award (including prize money).
- The top 3 KOM finishers are also required to attend award presentations in their racing kit within the designated time or risk of forfeiting their awards.
- Podium and award ceremonies will be held at the start/finish area approximately 30 minutes after the first finishers of the three heats.

1.4.3. PRIZES

- A minimum total of \$4 500.00 in cash and prizes will be awarded among overall winners and classifications. The cash prizes will be ensured by a minimum of 300 registered participants.
- The prize list will be displayed on at race Permanence and www.stevebauerclassic.com. Additional prizes may be announced at staging before the start and / or during the race.
